COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING (CIT)



Woodmont CITs will have fun interacting with young campers as they assist staff to facilitate activities, games, sports, art projects and more. Our CIT program is a great opportunity to strengthen leadership skills and confidence in a fun and safe environment while working with children.

PROGRAM

CITS spend the first part of their day with their assigned group of campers. They accompany their group to their scheduled activities and are invited to assist the counselors and activity instructors with their regular responsibilities.



LEADERSHIP WORKSHOPS

Once per week, CITs meet with our CIT Director to reflect on their experiences and further their growth as prospective Woodmont staff members. These workshops are sometimes led by Woodmont leadership members or visiting guest speakers.



INTENSIVES

Each afternoon, CITs have the option to join our oldest in-camp campers, Super Seniors, at their elective-based Intensives. This offers CITs the unique opportunity to continue their camper experience as they simultaneously develop their leadership skills alongside younger peers.
